The sole purpose of this agenda is to invite County Board Supervisors and the public to attend the following:

Calumet County will hold a public informational meeting regarding the 2020 Decennial Redistricting Process. Under Wis. Stat. § 59.10(3), all existing county district and ward lines are erased, and a county is able to draw new lines based on the results of the 2020 decennial census to reflect any population shifts over the last decade. This is a strictly non-partisan process which employs traditional concepts of redistricting including compactness, contiguity, and substantial equivalence of population. In addition, this redistricting process has nothing to do with state or federal legislative redistricting.

**The County Board Chair has declared that those Supervisors choosing to attend will be paid per diem.**
