**MINUTES OF MEETING

March 18, 2019**

I. **Communications:** Dan Nett, administrator at New Holstein, informed CESA 7 administration that the district will hire its own Early Childhood teacher for the 2019/20 school year.

II. **Director's Report:**

- **Budget:** The 2019-2020 budget proposal was presented. It includes a 3% increase in salary for teachers and paraprofessionals. While the CPI figure is slightly lower than 3% this year, some districts may exceed the CPI amount. The CDEB teachers' salaries match the districts' salaries. Unused funds are returned to the Calumet County Finance Department. The budget also includes a new part time position for a teacher specializing in Accessible Educational Materials (AEM) to assist IEP Teams in identifying students with print disability and assisting in obtaining AEM. Motion by Mary S. and 2nd by Ken I. to approve budget and send to county board. Motion carried.
- **DPI Update:** Bulletin 18-03 on AEM and Print disability. Bar-Lev describes the content of the new DPI Bulletin and its relation to the WCASS Guide on Print Disability.
- **CASE 2019 legislative agenda.** National priorities for CASE include: Support Access to Mental Health Services for students; prevent bullying and harassment by enhancing Social Emotional learning; support dispute resolution; support the development of seclusion and restraint procedures; address chronic teachers shortage; Maintain access to School Base Services and support high quality professional development for teachers.
- **WSEMS annual training 4/15/19.** Bar-Lev describes the annual training for the Wisconsin Special Education Mediation System mediators.
- **WSEMS Panel for spring conference May 1-3, 2019.** A panel of special education directors and parent advocates will describe how teachers and parents participate in the mediation process.
- **IEP Transition Services for special education students was described.**
