WHEREAS, Calumet County is a participant in the CDBG Program administered by the Wisconsin Department of Administration; and

WHEREAS, On September 23, 2003, the Calumet County Board of Supervisors passed Ordinance 2003-12 to create Section 10-2 of the Calumet County Code adopting Wisconsin Statutes Section 106.50 relating to the equal rights of all persons to fair housing and providing means for the implementation and enforcement thereof; and

WHEREAS, Calumet County remains committed to the equal rights of all persons to fair housing and its implementation and enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Calumet County reaffirms its support for fair housing opportunities for all persons as cited in Title VIII of the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Fair Housing Act), as amended, which prohibits discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of dwellings, and in other housing-related transactions, based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status (including children under the age of 18 living with parents or legal custodians, pregnant women, and people securing custody of children under the age of 18), and disability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That within available resources of Calumet County, all persons who feel that they have been discriminated against in any housing or real estate purchase, conveyance or transaction based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status (including children under the age of 18 living with parents or legal custodians, pregnant women, and people securing custody of children under the age of 18), and disability, are encouraged to seek equity under federal and state laws by filing a complaint with the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development or the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development using complaint forms available upon request.

Calumet County shall publicize this Resolution; through posting and distribution, Calumet County shall cause residents, owners of real estate, builders, developers, and mortgage lenders to become aware of their respective responsibilities and rights under Federal Fair Housing legislation, and all other applicable state or local laws or ordinances.

WHEREAS, Tourism in the Greater Fox Cities region including Calumet County has faced economic injury as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, The US Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration (EDA) has issued a competitive Notice of Funding Opportunity as part of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act; and

WHEREAS, The City of Appleton will submit a competitive grant application to the EDA Cares Act Program to create a Tourism Master Plan that will identify potential investments in tourism-related development that will spur economic development activities, support workforce development and help to balance the tourism portfolio in the region including the Calumet County communities in the Fox Cities Convention and Visitors Bureau area of Appleton, Menasha, Harrison, Sherwood, and Woodville; and

WHEREAS, The City of Appleton grant application for \$200,000 requires a 20% match, or up to \$40,000, with the match being contributed after receipt of the grant by project partners including the Fox Cities Convention and Visitors Bureau, City of Appleton, and Calumet County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Calumet County Board of Supervisors assembled hereby authorize and direct the County Administrator, in coordination with the Community Economic Development Director, to support the City of Appleton's EDA CARES Act project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Calumet County will contribute an amount not to exceed \$4,000 from the Calumet County Community Economic Development budget to be used as match for the grant.
