II. Director's Report:

A. AMHE Report. Elizabeth Langteau, Coordinator and Coach of the Allies in Mental Health Education (AMHE) for CESA 7 describes:

**AMHE Vision**

Learners will be supported in their Social and Emotional Learning development to improve educational outcomes and promote lifelong health and wellness for ALL, with focused and responsive access for those with increasing mental health needs.

**AMHE Mission:**

Allies in Mental Health Education (AMHE) is committed to the development of sustainable school systems that support the health and wellbeing of all learners through a collaborative, integrative model that includes school, family, and community by increasing awareness and capacity to collaborate, plan, and implement an equitable multi-level system of supports (promotion, prevention, and response).

Elizabeth also described the ongoing AMHE training in the Brillion, Chilton, Hilbert and New Holstein School Districts, and the future plans of AMHE implementation in Stockbridge.

- B. Bar-Lev described that the state funding for all 3 CCDEB's including Calumet County is expected to remain the same through fiscal year 2021 based DPI's Summary of State Support for K-12 Education. Handouts provided.
- C. DPI Update. School Districts of Brillion and Stockbridge completed the 2018 DPI Self-Assessment, and are awaiting the verification process that will extend through May 31, 2019. Handouts were provided.
- D. Bar-Lev explained the new process of local school districts' LEA determination status as well as provided DPI handouts describing the new process .
- E. Bar-Lev explained the history and services provided by the Wisconsin Special Education Mediation including free Mediation and IEP Facilitation to parents of SwD and school districts.
- F. Handouts describing Special Needs Scholarship Program FAQ and the location of such private schools.

G. Bar-Lev shared a handout from the CESA 7 Business Office, detailing how CESA 7 is utilizing the CDEB Indirect Cost funding.
