 - a. Amber O'Brien, Agriculture Extension Educator
 - Field Day Amber presented information on the CCASA (Calumet County Ag Stewardship Alliance) Field Day which will be held at the corner of County E and Twain Road, Chilton, on August 25. The Calumet County Forage Council will also be holding their first Corn Silage Dry Down Day in conjunction with this event at the Ken Rach Farm.

 - UW-Madison, Division of Extension Update Emphasis on Smart Restart to phase in on-campus instruction - Extension has some flexibility moving forward; however, telecommuting is still the primary means of work for Extension Educators.
 - Budget Overview The Calumet County Extension 2021 budget request was submitted to the Finance Director on August 7. Three laptop computers have been requested. We are utilizing funds for 2020 to purchase cell phones for Carlea and Amber to increase their efficiency and effectiveness and be responsive to clients; therefore, only the data plan will be included in the 2021 budget. The contract for UW positions has changed to extend the \$10,000 first educator discount through 2022.

Chris updated the committee on Hannah Phillips, Foodwise Healthy Communities Coordinator, grant project on Healthy Gardens with Ledgeview Nature Center and the Calumet County Master Gardeners. Due to COVID-19, that project has been put on hold for the summer; however, she now will be able to start site prep work in the fall.
