

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

CALUMET COUNTY FIRE CHIEFS ASSOCIATION

Organized June 7, 1980

---

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the organization shall be Calumet County Fire Chiefs Association. Meetings will be held the first Wednesday of each quarter at 8:00 PM.

ARTICLE II

Dues

Section 1. Dues for the year shall be \$10.00, which entitles each department 3 members.

ARTICLE III

Elective Officers

Section 1. Officers shall be elected at the July meeting for a two year term.

Section 2. Officers shall be one president, one vice president and one secretary/treasurer.

Section 3. In case a vacancy occurs in any office, a new officer shall be appointed, to fill the unexpired term, by the president.

Section 4. In case a vacancy occurs in the presidency, the vice president will step up to president.

ARTICLE IV

Voting Rights

Section 1. Only the chief will have voting power. If the chief cannot attend, an appointed member of his department shall ask the secretary for voting rights.

ARTICLE V

Violations

Section 1. Any member missing four (4) consecutive meetings from July to July shall be dropped from the membership.

ARTICLE VI  
Retirement

Section 1. A retiring chief will receive a gift of \$15.00 from the Chiefs Association.

Section 2. A retired chief may attend any meeting of the association with (no) no voting rights.

Section 3. A retired chief and his wife shall be invited to the Annual Ladies night - Dutch Treat.

Section 4. Retirement age shall be 55.

ARTICLE VII  
Funerals

Section 1. A memorial of \$25.00 shall be sent to the family of the deceased chief. (Chiefs only).
