

Order #2

Rescind Order #1 - Local Health Plan for Calumet County – Phase A

In response to community and business leader comments, and the uncertain ability to enforce such general orders, as interpreted by the recent Wisconsin Supreme Court decision *Wisconsin Legislature vs. Palm*, Calumet County Public Health Officer Bonnie Kolbe, announces that Calumet County Health Order #1 shall be rescinded effective immediately.

Duration. This order shall remain in effect until revoked or superseded by subsequent order.

It is recommended that individuals continue to:

- Maintain physical distancing of six (6) feet between people not residing in a single living unit or household;
- Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds as frequently as possible or using hand sanitizer;
- Cover coughs or sneezes (into the sleeve or elbow, not hands);
- Regularly clean high-touch surfaces;
- Not shake hands;
- Use a mask or cloth face covering. Note: the use of masks or cloth face coverings is strongly recommended but shall not be required due to equity concerns regarding the challenges that either may cause for individuals because of disabilities and/or shortages of PPE; and
- Follow all other public health recommendations issued by State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services, and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to reduce the risk of becoming infected or transmitting COVID-19 during this pandemic.

For specific guidance for businesses, it is recommended that industries follow the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation Reopen Guidelines.
