Can I recycle aluminum foil and pans?

Aluminum foil and pans are 100% recyclable as long as they are completely free of any food debris. Residual food debris left on pans and foil can contaminate the aluminum when it is being recycled. Most aluminum foil and pans are not taken at many recycling plants because of the possible left over food debris.

While aluminum cans are very easy to recycle and can be put in your curbside recycling, aluminum foil and pans can not mix with them because they melt at different temperatures. This can cause contaminations in the recycled aluminum.

Where can I recycle Aluminum foil and pans?

One local recycling location for aluminum foil is Sadoff Iron & Metal. They have locations in Fond du Lac, Green Bay, Sheboygan, Manitowoc, and Oshkosh.



Did you know?

You can reuse aluminum foil in many different ways including:

- Sharpening knives and scissors
- Removing tarnish from silver
- In place of steel wool for scrubbing pans
